**Prof Bi Puranen** is Associate Professor in the History of Economics at the University of Stockholm and she did her doctoral thesis on Tuberculosis. She was Research Director at the Demographic Database in Sweden, which is a part of the University of Umeå from 1973-1984, whereafter she became Director of the Reseach Archives for Modern Media, at the University of Umeå. She has been Programme Director at the Institute for Futures Studies, Stockholm, which is a governmental research foundation and as such lead different research projects for ten years. She has during six years led the transformation project "Values as a Driving Force" (VDF) with the ultimate goal of changing the basic values of the Swedish Armed Forces (SAF) and adjoining security organisations and she has served as Secretary General in the World Values Survey since 1996. She was a member of the system panel on Emergency Management Foresight at the Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences with the goal of promoting greater cooperation between research and society. In her research she has worked with the development of standards for values on security, and the development of a reference framework of values for different organisations that need to work together during emergencies and in international operations. She has led the work on values implementation into public authorities such as one of the main European energy producer Vattenfall and the Swedish national authority assigned the overall responsibility for the entire road transport system (Swedish Road Administration).
