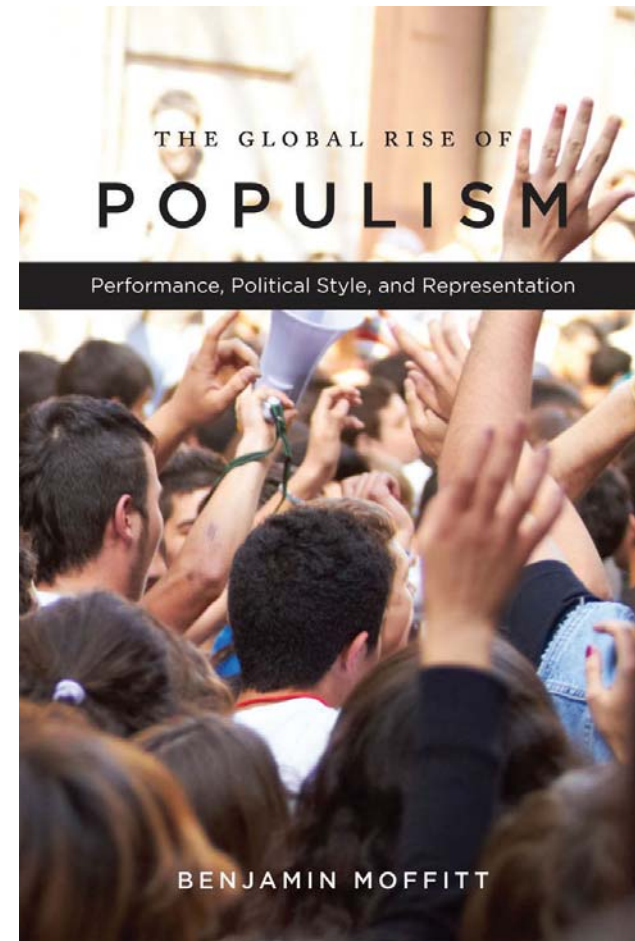

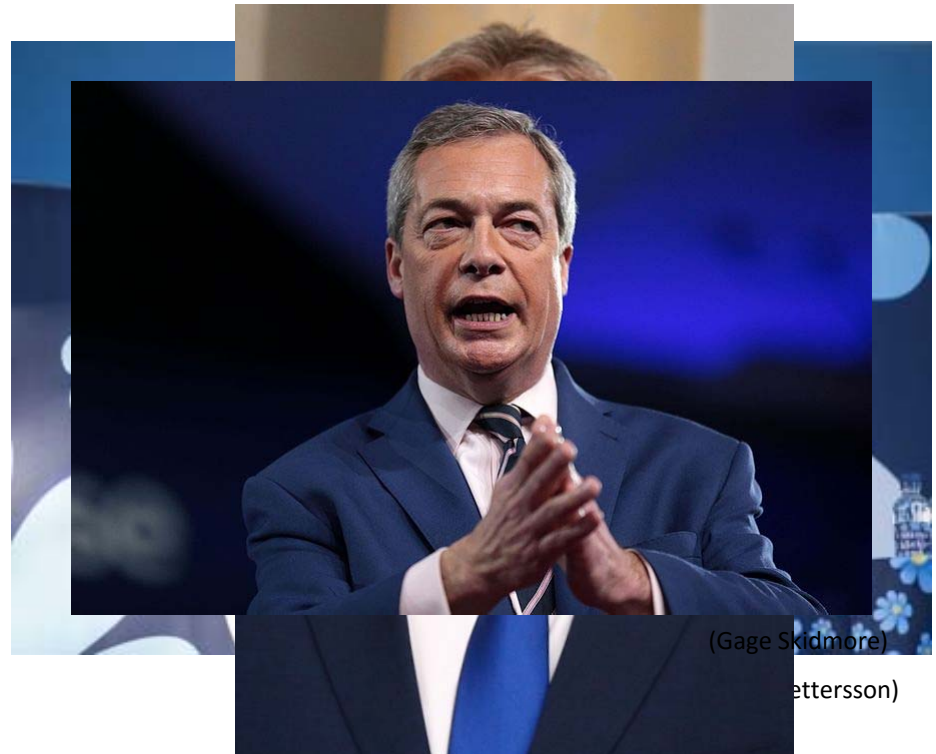

3. Globalism shifts the boundaries of sovereignty
